Czabok Simpson Motorsport (CSM) Expands into Porsche Carrera Cup North America for 2026 with plans to run two cars fulltime in the 2026 season.

CSM is proud to announce its expansion into Porsche Carrera Cup North America in 2026, marking a significant milestone in the team's continued growth and commitment to Porsche's premier customer racing platforms. The program will run alongside the team's ongoing IMSA Michelin Pilot Challenge GS campaign, which also features Porsche machinery.

In preparation for the team's Carrera Cup debut, CSM has placed an order for the all-new 2026 Porsche 911 Cup cars, which will feature the latest type 992.2 generation platform—set to be introduced by Porsche Motorsport for the upcoming season.

"This is an exciting next step for our organization," said Stephen Simpson, CSM co-owner.

"We've established a strong foundation with Porsche in IMSA Michelin Pilot Challenge, and expanding into Carrera Cup North America allows us to further develop talent, deepen our relationship with Porsche, and compete at an elite level in a one-make format."

The Porsche Carrera Cup North America series has quickly become one of the continent's most competitive and professionally run one-make championships, attracting rising stars, experienced professionals, and factory talent. With the introduction of the 911 Cup car (type 992.2), the 2026 season is expected to bring heightened performance, innovation, and international visibility.

"We're building a comprehensive multi-series program with Porsche that offers a clear ladder of development," added Matthias Czabok, CSM co-owner. With new Gen 2 cars on order, we're committed to being competitive right from the start."

The team's IMSA Michelin Pilot Challenge GS campaign will continue into the 2026 season, with the only change being a reduction from three cars to two full-time cars.
